Full Day (9am – 3pm)

- 8:00 Meet at church with staff for preparation
- 8:30 Pre-day meeting and Prayer time with congregation leaders and volunteers.
- 9:00 Campers arrive – Daily Registration (done by congregation)
- 9:15 Alpha (opening program with worship songs, puppet show, Bible story intro)
- 9:45 Cabin Time #1 (Age groups split up and go to Bible Encounter, Group Building/Games, Crafts)
- 10:30 Snack
- 10:45 Cabin Time #2
- 11:30 Round-A-Long (high energy campy songs and other fun skits)
- 12:00 Lunch
- 12:30 Horizontal Time (a calm “nap” related time. Kids rest for 15 minutes)
- 12:45 Koinonia (large group games, everyone is involved)
Pre-school kids depart for the day.
- 1:30 Cabin Time #3
- 2:15 PTWG (Personal Time With God – an organized prayer activity)
- 2:30 Omega (closing worship and review the Bible story)
- 3:00 Campers depart *
- 3:15 Staff and volunteers clean up
- 3:30 Lutherhaven team debriefs with volunteers and coordinators and talk about the day. (Important)**

Camper Choice Format; Full Day

- 9:45 Challenge Course – Each of the three age groups (k-2; 3-4; 5-6) goes with a different LH staff for group building activities

- 10:45 Bible Encounter – Each of the three age groups goes with a LH staff for Bible Study and related activities
- 11:45 Personal Time with God – LH Staff lead separate age groups in a reflective prayer time (*could also have a silly songs time here)
- 12:00 Lunch
- 12:30 Koinonia (large group songs and games)
- 1:00 Choice Time – Campers sign up for the activity they want to attend: creative skills, nature games, or archery (grades K-6) – all led by LH staff)
- 1:45 Choice Time (Campers sign up for another activity: creative skills, games, or archery)
- 2:30 Omega (closing program / wrap up)
- 3:00 Campers Depart
- 3:15 Staff and volunteers clean up
- 3:30 Lutherhaven team debriefs with volunteers and coordinators and talk about the day. (Important)**
