

Behavior Expectations for Students

1. School rules still apply.
2. Respect other students, adults, camp property, and yourself. Students will help clean up after meals and are responsible for keeping living spaces clean.
3. Go nowhere alone! Always have at least two people with you. If something should happen, you have one person to go for help and one to stay with you.
4. Cabins - only go back to your cabin with the permission of an adult and only enter your own cabin or room. No food is to be kept in the cabins.
5. Privacy - privacy of all persons is expected and maintained throughout your time at camp. People are encouraged to change clothes in the bathrooms or other private changing areas. Respect the privacy of all people at all times.
6. Preserve the natural environment at all times. Stay on designated paths and maintain proper distance from animals. No fires are to be built outside without checking with the camp staff.
7. Shoes must be worn at all times when outside your cabin.
8. No obscene or degrading language is to be used at camp.
9. When an adult puts up the Quiet Coyote signal, be quiet and attentive.
10. Do not go near the stream/river/lake/dock without an adult.
11. Follow directions of Outdoor Education Staff, teachers, and adult chaperones at all times.
